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‘Alfresco’ 2007

Alfresco is a refreshing new wine from Stefano Lubiana Wines.

Stylistically it fits somewhere between dry table wine and Moscato. Extremely drinkable, it is fresh lively aromatic with a low alcohol of just 11.0%.



Where Italian Moscato's are fermented in pressurised tanks to maintain their fizz, this wine is made using a unique method involving fermentation of clear juice at a temperature of 5 degrees Celsius. This has the effect of capturing the aroma and tropical characters of the Riesling grape while providing an almost creamy fine spritz. This 'lagering' process more commonly used in beer production, illustrates the imagination and creativity behind our wines and our never ending desire to push the boundaries of conventional Australian winemaking.

We believe the Alfresco's low alcohol, zippy freshness and low sweetness make it a perfect pre-aperitive (if such a word exists), meaning served icy cold in a shot glass of about 70ml just as you sit down to a meal.

The wine should be drunk briskly to cleanse the palate before moving on to an aperitive of sparkling wine. It could also accompany desert or be enjoyed at any time of the day.
